General Rules:

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## Homework:

- Since a majority of our work will be online, you will be turning in most assignments to either Schoology or Google Classroom.
- Paper copies of work will be turned in to the homework bins located in the black shelves.

## Late Work:

- All assignments should be turned in on the due date.
- There are zero exceptions for larger assignments, such as projects, speeches, essays, etc.
- If you turn in a typical homework assignment the day after the due date, you will receive half credit.
- To get any type of credit for late assignments, you must turn in your work within a week of the due date. Otherwise, you will receive a zero.

## Absent Work:

- You are not exempt from any work done in class while you are gone.
- **You** will be responsible for asking about what you missed.
- Make sure to check my Weebly, Schoology, and the absent folder at the front of the classroom.
- You will have **2 days** to complete your absent work in order to receive full credit.
  - For example, if work is assigned on Monday, the absent work due date will be on Wednesday.
- If you have an **unexcused absence**, all work will be counted as zeroes.
  - Even so, you will want to do the work in case your unexcused absence changes to excused.

## Plagiarism:

- Plagiarism or cheating of any kind is unacceptable.
- You will receive an automatic zero.
- If someone else let you use his/her work, he/she will also receive a zero.
- This concept also includes working in groups when it's an individual assignment.
- For repeat offenders, there can be other consequences as well.

## Extra Credit:

- There will be extra credit opportunities throughout the year.
- Please note that these will not necessarily be at the end of the quarter or semester, so you will want to take advantage of these opportunities if you think you might need the help later.

## MLA Format:

- All of your assignments should be in MLA format.
- This includes smaller details, such as your name and date.
- Don't worry! We will review this in our first week.
